About

We opened Beacon Hill Books & Cafe at the end of September 2022. Owner Melissa Fetter collaborated on the interior of the bookstore with Dallas-based designer, Cathy Kincaid. The brownstone in Beacon Hill's historic neighborhood has 5 levels. The cafe is on the ground floor and the bookstore spans three stories (plus staff offices on the 5th floor). Prior to the bookstore opening, the building housed the "Hungry I" restaurant for nearly 40 years. In the 1800s, the brownstone belonged to a globe-maker.

The store has many thoughtful nooks, including rooms dedicated to food writing and aesthetics/art. We also curate a collection of Persephone Books, titles by a UK-based publisher that reprints neglected fiction and non-fiction, mostly by women writers from the mid-twentieth century.






Quick Facts
